Case Study: Southern New Hampshire University

In 2007, Southern New Hampshire University (SNHU) entered a Renewable Energy Hedge agreement and began offsetting all carbon emissions while stabilizing their energy costs for 15 years. With conservative estimated energy price increases, their average projected savings are calculated to be \$1.2 million annually for electricity and gas. SNHU is also receiving 17,500 RECs per year to offset the estimated 11,400 tons of carbon dioxide the university emits annually and to use for other projects. In 2008, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency named SNHU a, "College and University Green Power Challenge Champion for 2007-2008."
